Are you age 16 or older and living without a parent or guardian?

If so, you may be eligible for the following :

- Access to a free Florida birth certificate.
- Access to a free Florida identification card.

Keys to Independence Program may Assist with Cost of:

- Driver's Education
- Licensure
- Motor Vehicle Insurance
- Gas Card for Transportation for Educational Purposes

- FAFSA Application
- Florida Tuition and Fee Exemptions
- Fee Waiver for College Entrance Exams

Unaccompanied Youth in Transition



Are you living without a parent or legal guardian?

You Have the Right to:

- Receive a free, appropriate public education.
- Enroll in an eligible school immediately, even if lacking required documents.
- Attend classes while the school gathers documents.



- Continue attending school of origin.
- Receive transportation to and from the school of origin, if requested.
- Receive educational services comparable to those provided to other students, according to the student's needs.
